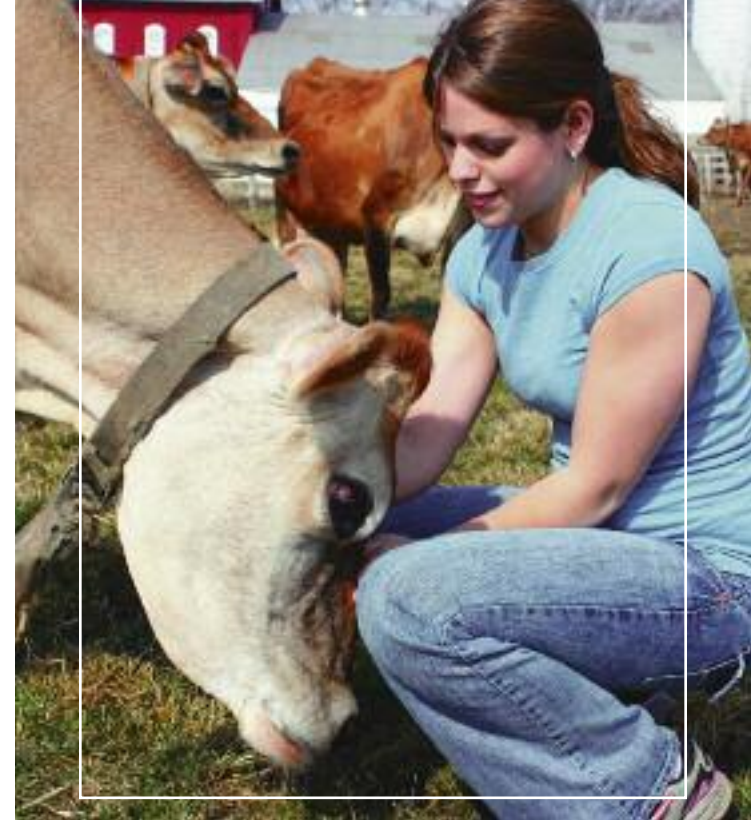

WHY A FOUNDATION?

With a look at the future, AABP's Board of Directors established The AABP Foundation in September 2006 and has applied to the Internal Revenue Service for 501c3 nonprofit status. Its goals for the Foundation are to provide a consistent source of funds in support of these areas that are crucial to the advancement of bovine medicine and practice:

- **New Bovine Veterinarians**—Attract young people who will choose careers in food supply veterinary medicine.
- **More CE**—Increase and broaden continuing education opportunities for AABP members and bovine practitioners in general.
- **Backing for Applied Research**—Promote projects in the areas of animal production, nutrition, and management, including research proposals from practitioners.
- **Farmer & Consumer Communication**—Educate dairy and beef farmers as well as urban consumers with regard to the involvement of AABP members in safe and economic animal protein production.
- **AABP Interests**—Fund projects that uphold the strategic objectives of the AABP.

AABP Foundation monies will be distributed as externships and grants. Recipients may also qualify to receive technological support or equipment that advances distance learning opportunities for AABP members.

HOW IS THE FOUNDATION ADMINISTERED?

The AABP Foundation is governed by a Board of Directors whose charter members include:

Through its Articles of Incorporation, two Foundation Board members must serve on the AABP Board of Directors, which chooses additional Foundation Board members from the AABP membership.

HOW CAN I HELP?

Your pledge is welcome and encouraged!

AABP is providing the Foundation with startup funds totaling \$200,000 to be placed in an Expendable Fund with no spending restrictions. The Foundation will also maintain Endowment and Designated Funds. Because 501c3 status has not yet been awarded, The AABP Foundation is currently accepting pledges only.

You can choose from the following pledge categories:

■ Expendable Fund Donation

Expendable funds will be available for Foundation purposes without spending restrictions.

■ Endowed Fund Donation

Endowment funds will not be spent, but interest income earned by these funds can be used for Foundation purposes.

■ Designated Fund Donation

Designated funds are donated with allocation to a specific purpose (minimum \$20,000). Board approval is required. Designated Funds can be endowed, expendable, or a combination.
